

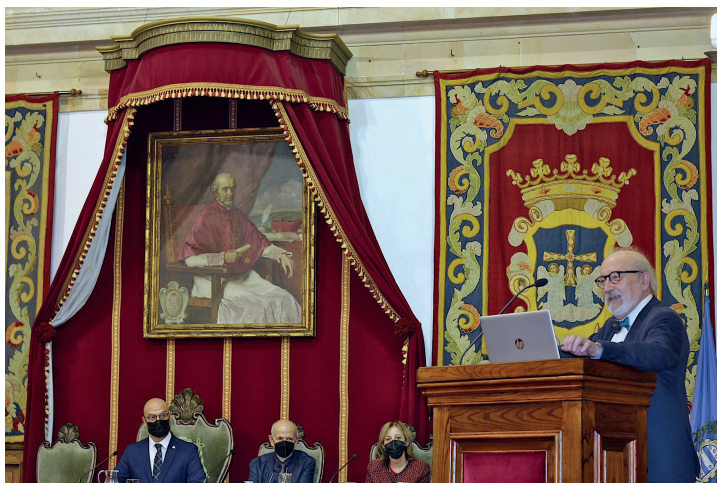
### APPOINTMENT OF PROFESSOR MANUEL PRIETO AS SEM HONORARY MEMBER

Professor Manuel Prieto (University of Oviedo, Spain) was named Honorary Member of the Spanish Mineralogical Society (SEM) on 1 October 2021. The Spanish Mineralogical Society by law establishes that the recipients of the Honorary Member appointment must be highly acclaimed researchers or must have contributed in a relevant way to the dignity and development of the SEM. Professor Prieto was President of the Spanish Mineralogical Society from 2007 to 2010. As president, his most important contribution was to propose the SEM as one of the scientific societies in charge of publishing *Elements: An International Magazine of Mineralogy, Geochemistry, and Petrology*. Currently, *Elements* is published by 18 scientific societies.

When considering his outstanding career in crystallography and in applied geochemical and mineralogical research (as evidenced by the publication of more than 100 research papers and 10 book chapters; the supervision of 13 PhDs; his contribution to the SEM), the SEM General Assembly, which was held 26 June 2019 in Ronda (Spain), approved his appointment as SEM Honorary Member.
